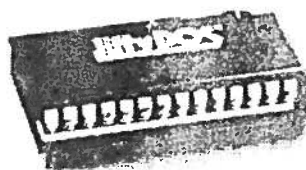

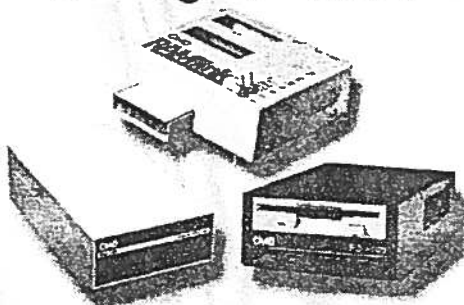

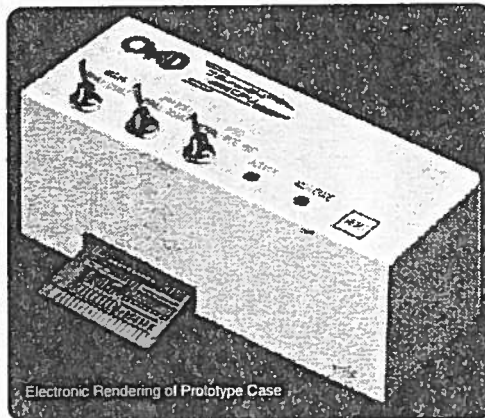

The SuperCPU's 20 Mhz microprocessor handles up to 16 MB of system memory, features 16 bit registers and offers full 6502, 6510 and 8502 compatibility. These features make it easy to modify and/or create software that is more sophisticated and faster than ever before!

What is the SuperCPU?

The Super 64 CPU is an accelerator module that speeds up the operation of your C-64/128 computer by introducing a modern high speed microprocessor to your C-64 or C-128 computer. It plugs directly into the cartridge port, and gives your computer the extra horsepower it has always needed for faster number crunching. What does this mean in layman's terms: Smooth scrolling in Word Processors, faster screen updating in all programs, faster calculations in spreadsheets, faster printing and limitless possibilities if you enjoy programming. In short, it will enhance virtually every facet of computing! Now, with all of this new found speed, your disk drives will need to keep up with the computer. We've thought about that too and built-in the computer portion of JiffyDOS (CMD's disk speed enhancement speed). If you are unfamiliar with JiffyDOS it is a two chip system for the computer and disk drive(s) (See details later in this catalog. If you don't already have JiffyDOS you need only add the disk drive chip(s) to complete JiffyDOS system. At the heart of the SuperCPU is the W65C816S microprocessor running at 20 MHz and a CPLD (Complex Programmable Logic Device IC) which contains the custom logic required to mimic the characteristics of the C-64 or C-128 (Both modes). The C-64 version also contains 128K Bytes of high-speed Static RAM (the same type of high-speed cache memory found in 486/Pentium systems), and 64K Bytes of ROM. The 128 version will include additional RAM, ROM and custom logic to allow it to operate in both 64 and 128 modes. Unfortunately CP/M will not be supported by the SuperCPU.

Installation

Installing the SuperCPU 64 is simple: just plug it into the Cartridge port. No additional wiring, jumpers or ugly cables need to be installed inside of the computer. (The C-128 version may, however, require a jumper clip.)

Physical Characteristics

The SuperCPU is contained within an enclosure that measures approximately 6" wide by 3" high and 2" deep. The enclosure has an opening for the Cartridge Port Pass-Thru connector at the rear, precisely in line with the computer's Cartridge Port. The unit is about the same width as a RAMLink or Commodore REU. The main circuit board inside the SuperCPU mounts vertically, keeping the depth of the unit to a minimum. This helps to prevent devices plugged into the pass-thru port from extending too far back from the computer. Three easy-to-use toggle switches line the upper front edge of the unit: a Master Enable/Disable switch, a JiffyDOS Enable/Disable switch, and a Speed selection switch. Also included is a built-in reset switch and Speed Indicator LED.

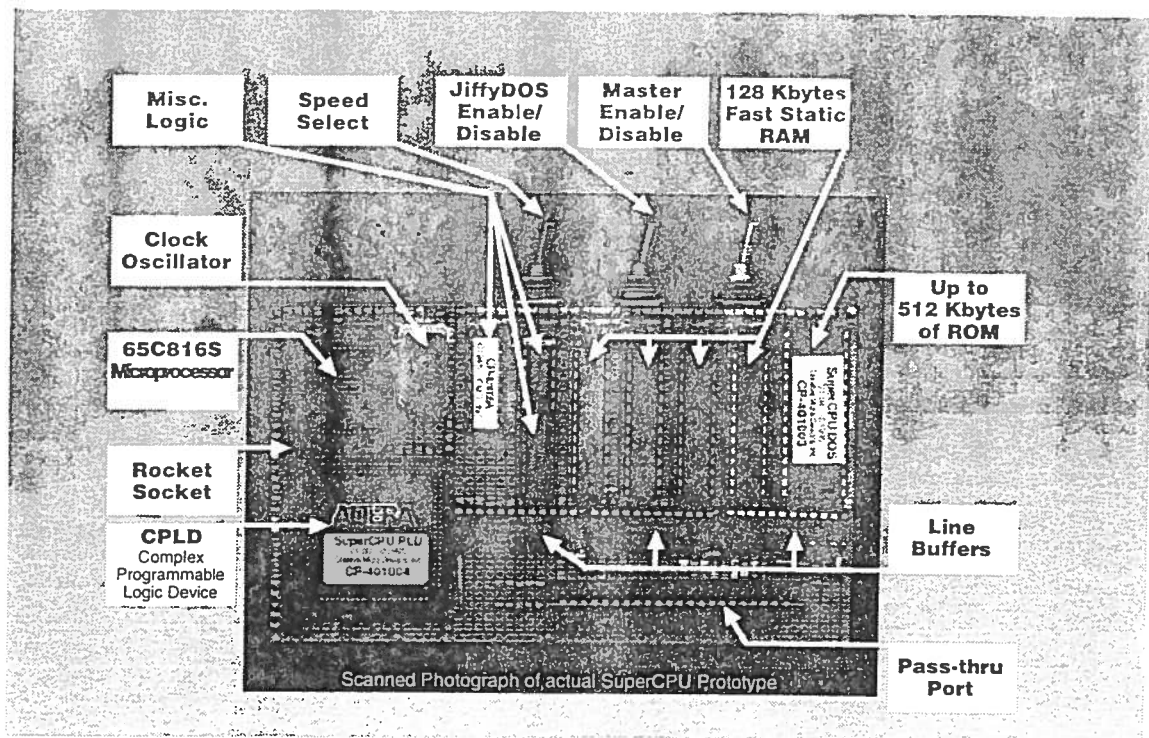
Operation

Operating the SuperCPU requires no special knowledge. It is basically transparent and allows you to operate the C-64/128 in the same manner as you always have, with only one exception — the benefit of greatly accelerated speed. Even programmers will have little to change to remain compatible. Other than an adjustment to any timing loops or removal of illegal opcodes nothing needs to change. But chances are

that you will want to take advantage of the many new additions: extra RAM, additional registers and much more. The toggle switches on the unit are clearly labeled, easily accessible, and can be used without having to refer to a manual in order to determine their function. As with CMD's RAMLink, the SuperCPU has been designed to work out-of-the-box with any C-64 or 128 computer—no manual "tuning" adjustments will be required.

Compatibility

The SuperCPU 64 operates with C-64 and C-64c computers as well as the C-128/128-D in 64 mode. The W65C816S supports all legal 6502/6510/8502 opcodes, and will therefore provide a very high level of compatibility with existing software. The C-64 memory map is emulated exactly by the CPLD, and proprietary write-thru logic in this chip ensures full compatibility with all VIC graphic modes and memory mapping.

REU's: The CPLD chip in the SuperCPU includes special DMA transfer logic to provide 100% compatibility with all types of data transfers to and from Commodore REU's. The unit does not have to be slowed down to 1 MHz in order to initiate a DMA transfer to and from the REU.

RAMLink: The Super CPU is compatible with RAMLink, and contains its own version of RL-DOS, which runs from the SuperCPU's high-speed Static RAM. The faster RL-DOS, along with the efficiency of new 65C816S opcodes allows faster data transfers to and from RAMCard memory and also speeds up data transfers to/from CMD HD Series hard drives connected to the parallel port.

GEOS: Version 2.0 will be 100% compatible. Special software will be provided with the SuperCPU allowing GEOS to run at the full 20 Mhz speed.

Performance

To help achieve its high level of performance and to accommodate the 20 Mhz speed, all operating system routines are downloaded into the SuperCPU's 64K of high-speed Static RAM during power-up. This feature eliminates the bottleneck caused by ROM-based operating system code (on PC's, this technique is called ROM-BIOS shadowing). 64K of high-speed SRAM remains free for programs. Additionally, buffered write-thru circuitry (similar to PC cache controllers) eliminates the need to slow down when writing data into the computer. In preliminary tests, CMD has recorded speed increases as high as 22 times faster than a stock C-64 or 128(64

mode).

Additional Features

Built-in JiffyDOS Kernal ROM: The computer portion of JiffyDOS is built into the SuperCPU, providing DOS-Wedge commands and enabling high-speed serial transfer rates to and from JiffyDOS-equipped disk drives. The JiffyDOS Enable/Disable switch is designed to function on the fly without disabling the accelerator itself.

Cartridge Port Pass-Thru: Enables the full use of most plug-in hardware devices such as REU's, RAMLink, SwiftLink, SID Cartridge, GEORAM, and some software cartridges. These devices will work while the accelerator is running at 20 Mhz.

GEOS Software: Custom software to optimize GEOS operation is provided. Additionally, an intelligent write-thru hardware circuit designed especially for GEOS effectively eliminates major performance bottlenecks associated with previous accelerator designs. Coupled with the 20 Mhz clock speed, this feature will boost the performance of GEOS far beyond anything previously available.

Speed Selection: The speed selection switch provides two options: Slow (1 Mhz) mode for compatibility with programs (such as some games) that may operate too quickly in the turbo mode; and Turbo mode

(1 MHz) mode for compatibility with programs (such as some games) that may operate too quickly in the turbo mode; 2) a "soft" Turbo mode which operates at 20 MHz and provides programs with a software speed selection register for switching to Slow speed when necessary; and 3) a "forced" Turbo mode which keeps the CPU in 20 MHz mode regardless of the setting of the software register. This mode is useful for providing compatibility with existing programs that unintentionally alter the software register. (Note: The SuperCPU performs disk access functions properly in all modes.) Speed modes may be toggled while the SuperCPU is operating without quitting from a program.

Expansion Capabilities

The SuperCPU includes an internal connector (called the "Rocket Socket") which will enable the user to plug in a CMD-supplied RAM Expansion card similar to the RAMCard found in RAMLink. Each card will have 128K of RAM on-board plus SIMM sockets for an additional 1 to 16 Megabytes of Dynamic RAM (DRAM). The RAM on this card is for use as system memory. Even without the extra SIMM(s), the RAMCard gives programmers a full 192K for use in programs (Includes the 64K found on the SuperCPU motherboard). Simply put, this is like having a C-64 or C-128 with up to 16 MB's of internal system memory. This additional memory gives programmers the opportunity to push the Commodore further than ever before!

Developer Support

CMD is actively seeking developers who are willing to create new commercial software and/or modify existing software to take full advantage of the SuperCPU. A comprehensive developers package will be available. It will include an enhanced version of the Buddy Assembler which has been modified to fully support the SuperCPU. Also, extensive documentation will provide pertinent technical specifications, guidelines, and sample code. This package helps developers to produce programs which take advantage of the 65C816S's enhanced instruction set, 16 MB addressing capability (for users with the optional SuperRAM Expansion Card), as well as other SuperCPU capabilities. Developers are encouraged to contact CMD for further details.

Programming Features

The microprocessor used in the SuperCPU has an internal 16 bit architecture and implements a host of new functions such as a speed register for controlling the processor's clock speed. An additional register controls the SuperCPU's WriteSmart™ function, which determines what areas of the SuperCPU memory are mirrored in the host computer. Applications utilizing this feature will greatly increase their performance.

Availability

Both versions of the SuperCPU are nearing completion at the time this is being written. The production of the SuperCPU-64 will

begin in mid-to-late May 1996 and its counterpart, the SuperCPU-128 should begin production within 90 days of the C-64 versions release.

CMD continues to accept advanced orders with a \$50.00 deposit for the SuperCPU-64. The \$50.00 deposit guarantees a maximum price of \$199.00.

A \$50.00 deposit for the SuperCPU-128 is also being accepted and will guarantee a maximum price of \$299.00.

Advanced orders being paid for by credit card will be billed \$50.00 upon receipt and the balance charged automatically shortly before your unit is ready for shipment. Deposits paid for by check or money order, must be paid in full before the unit is ready to ship.

In Closing

The SuperCPU promises to take Commodore users to a level that has never before been possible. However, it remains a work-in-progress, and as such will take a while longer before details are set-in-stone.

What we can tell you is that CMD is creating a powerful new engine for our computers. This product without doubt is the most significant advancement since the release of the Commodore itself.

So what is the Super CPU in layman's terms?

So what is the Super CPU?

The Super CPU is a cartridge port module that plugs into your C-64 or C-128 and provides your computer with all of the horsepower you need to keep pace with today's newer, faster (and more expensive) computers. Inside of the cartridge is a newer high-speed microprocessor which pushes your C-64/128 from 1 or 2 MHz to 20 MHz speed. That means that it can perform 20 million cycles per second instead of 1 or 2 million cycles per second. It's like a turbo charger for your Commodore.

The microprocessor in your computer is responsible for all of the mathematical calculations that are necessary to make your computer run. These calculations are responsible for functions as basic as calculating formulas within a spreadsheet, sorting lists in a database, updating the screen display and the execution of a program. As you can see, there is a huge benefit in performing these and other tasks at speeds 20 times greater than the stock system.

In addition to its processing capabilities, we have included the computer portion of the JiffyDOS disk drive speed enhancement system. JiffyDOS enhances the speeds (up to 15 times) at which the computer and drives can communicate. Usually this requires replacing the kernel ROM in the computer and the DOS chip in the disk drive. However, with the JiffyDOS Kernel being built-in to the SuperCPU, there is no longer a need to put JiffyDOS in the computer — you need only swap the chip in your disk drive(s) to complete the JiffyDOS system.

Aside from its ability to speed up your existing software, the SuperCPU is going to allow developers to write new software that will not only perform better but offer more and better features than ever before possible. Why? Because the chip in the SuperCPU has a native mode which has more programming capabilities and features plus the ability to access up to 16 megabytes of system memory. That means that a single program can occupy up to 16 MB's of RAM instead of just 64K or 128K (that's up to 256 times the system memory).

How can I benefit from using a SuperCPU?

The benefits of a 20 times speed increase can be more noticeable in some programs than in other programs. Those that benefit most would be:

BASIC Programs: The SuperCPU enhances all BASIC programs even if they've been compiled. This eliminates the need for special machine language routines (ML) to gain reasonable speeds and makes it easy for even a novice to achieve desirable results without having to learn ML.

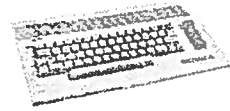
BBS Programs: Since most BBS's are written in BASIC, the benefits are obvious. Imagine how fast you can search message bases and user logs. Plus your users will find the board to be much more responsive. Couple the SuperCPU with a RAMLink or Hard Drive and your users will swear you bought a 486 or Pentium.

GEOS: Because GEOS is a graphical program, it really stretches the capabilities of a 1- or 2-MHz machine to the limit. The most noticeable improvement can be found when updating large areas of the screen, such as when you scroll through text in

GEOWrite or when moving around in GEOPaint or GEOPublish. It is also great for enhancing the speed of your printing—especially with PerfectPrint I.Q. Experienced GEOS users won't find it difficult to imagine the bliss they will experience when pages scroll nearly instantaneously, when spell checking no longer takes forever and when printing is no longer a "come back in a 1/2 hour" process. The SuperCPU speeds up virtually every aspect of GEOS including disk access.

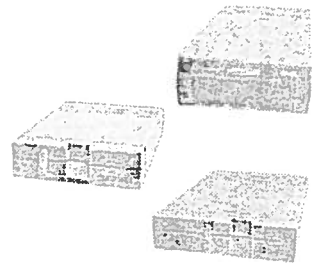

Testing Information

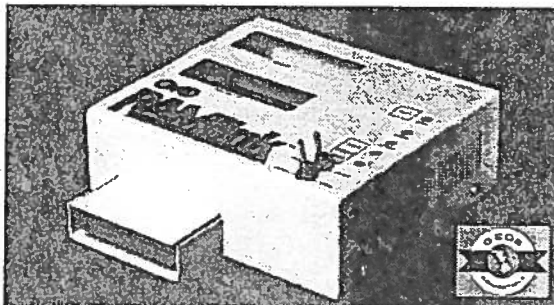

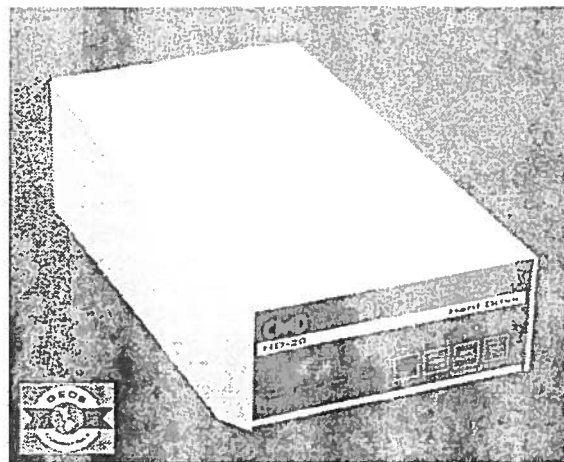

GEOS compatibility is accomplished easily by installing a new CONFIGURE file on your GEOS boot disk. Utilities have been provided to automatically set the GEOS clock from the HD's Real-Time Clock and to quickly navigate through and copy files between the HD's partitions. Easy-to-remember commands allow MS-DOS style subdirectories to be created within native mode partitions and within other subdirectories, and enable easy movement to other areas within the drive.

Future Expandability

Another important feature of CMD hard drives is that they are designed to be part of your future computer system. HD Series drives are based on SCSI and are equipped with an external SCSI port which allows them to be connected to many other types of computers (such as IBM, Macintosh, Amiga or Atari) using standard SCSI interfaces.

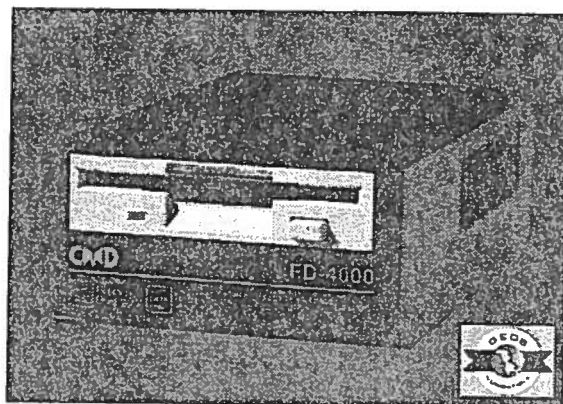

The FD is the most compatible 3.5" disk drive ever developed for Commodore computers. Why? Because of CMD's operating system. As you can see in the previous paragraphs, the FD has the flexibility of emulating Commodore's own 5.25" disks, and as a result, some software written to run only on these disk formats can run on the FD - but not on Commodore's own 1581. FD's are also great for use with GEOS, and with geoMakeBoot (see the GEOS products section) you can even boot GEOS directly from the FD.

FD's have also proven far more reliable than the old 1581 drives, due to the use of a modern disk controller chip and CMD's time-tested advanced operating system. Additionally, FD's also use new high-quality, low-power drive mechanisms. The result is a drive that runs cooler and quieter than the 1581, and without reliability problems which could cause the loss of important and valuable data.

Special Features

FD-2000 drives are equipped with several special features. Probably the most noticeable of these features is CMD's proprietary SWAP button. Capacity and Formatting

The FD-2000 is compatible with Double-Density disks (800K) in both CMD and 1581 formats, and High Density disks (1.6 MB) commonly used at 1.44 MB on other computer platforms. Note that due to a more efficient formatting method, the FD-2000 provides a higher capacity than the same disk formatted on an IBM compatible or Macintosh computer.

FD Series drives are capable of reading and writing three basic formats: 1581 (800K), CMD (800K, 1.6 MB) and MS-DOS (720K, 1.44 MB). The first format, 1581, is rather obvious - FD's can read and write standard 1581 disks, making it an ideal replacement for 1581 drives.

FD -2000 drives can also format disks in 720K, 1.44 MB, and 2.88 MB for use on MS-DOS machines through the use of SOGWAP's *Big Blue Reader*. With the ability to read and write MS-DOS disks, the FD is ideal for sharing files between Commodore and MS-DOS computers. (The *Big Blue Reader* is available from CMD as a separate product.)

CMD FD Partitioning

The FD utilizes the same powerful operating system found in CMD's HD Series hard drives and RAMLink. This unique and powerful DOS allows you to create multiple 1541, 1571 and 1581 emulation mode partitions which insure the highest levels of compatibility with existing commercial 64 and 128 software. Each of these partitions identically maps the track and sector layout and BAM placement of the disk drive being emulated. This means that most software which was written to run, for example, on a 1541, can run in a 1541 emulation mode partition on the FD-2000.

In addition, there are also Native Mode partitions. Although not quite as compatible as emulation mode partitions, Native Mode partitions work well with most software, and can be as large as the capacity of the disk (800K, or 1.6 MB). You may also use MS-DOS style subdirectories to organize your data within these often large partitions. Native Mode partitions are ideal for storing large amounts of data or graphics.

But don't let all of this talk about partitions scare you, partitions are easily created, deleted, and manipulated through FD-TOOLS; an easy-to-use utility developed specifically for the FD and the novice computer user. Partitions are merely a way to organize larger amounts of data. Simply think of a partition as being a piece of pie - a smaller more manageable portion of a larger object.
